

### **Fellowship Criteria**

Members who wish to apply for Fellowship can do so. The criteria is laid out below.

Candidates must meet criteria 1 to 4 and one of the remaining three criteria:

1. Must already be a member of the Association
2. Can demonstrate having successfully delivered a minimum of 5 years professional tutoring or 1 year of professional tuition plus 5 years of running a tutoring company
3. Provide three client or professional references to this affect
4. Submit a fellowship application setting out your contribution to the profession, and how this goes over and above what might be expected of the average tutor

One of the remaining 3 criteria:

1. Can demonstrate a contribution to the profession through for example:
  - delivery of courses or programmes in best tutoring practice for TTA or others
  - delivered a relevant session(s) at an appropriate conference or at TTA National Conference
  - have published an academic paper relating to tutoring or tutoring techniques examples could be:
    - a. Neuroscience,
    - b. Pedagogy,
    - c. Special Educational Needs
    - d. Online Tutoring techniques
    - e. etc
2. Have contributed significantly to the Association's work by volunteering and serving on a board, committee or panel, or have delivered a CPD programme
3. Can detail significant charitable work undertaken e.g: say by delivery of 100 hours tutoring or giving advice to schools, parents and LEAs, supporting underprivileged children or vulnerable adults, pro bono work etc
